

#### **Medal of Honor Memorial**

Over the last couple of years, the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversaries of important dates have been observed. In 2016 the Association celebrated the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the activation of what was initially designated the 504<sup>th</sup> Parachute Infantry Battalion, but would later be re-designated and finish the war as the



509<sup>th</sup> Parachute Infantry Battalion. Next year we will see the anniversaries of probably the most significant events of World War II for the Airborne in general and the 509<sup>th</sup> in particular. The invasions of Anzio, Southern France and the Battle of the Bulge will all mark 75 years.

One of the events to be recognized next year will be the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the February 8<sup>th</sup> action, where then Corporal Paul Huff, received his Medal of Honor in the Anzio beachhead. Paul Huff was a native of Cleveland, Tennessee and joined the Army in June of 1941. He was one of the original Troopers of the 504<sup>th</sup> PIB, and served with the Battalion at Forts Benning and Bragg, and in England. Huff participated in both combat jumps in North Africa and Avellino. Following the Avellino operation he fought with the Battalion at Monte Croce. and participated in the amphibious invasion of Anzio. Cpl. Huff was the first Paratrooper to be awarded the Medal of Honor.

As mentioned above, February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019 will mark 75 years since his Medal of Honor action near Carano, Italy. A memorial ceremony is being planned for Saturday, February 9<sup>th</sup> to commemorate this achievement. Paul Huff is buried in his hometown of Cleveland, Tennessee, and plans are to hold the ceremony at his gravesite. While it's still in the early stages for the ceremony, an honor guard, a laying of a wreath, and participation by the Huff family are all being planned for. As the date gets closer more details will be published in the newsletter and on Facebook.

# 509 PIA | GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES

#### Attendees:

A Quorum of the Executive Committee was Present: Jaime Garza, President; Dale Fairbanks, Treasurer; Margot Handscomb, Secretary; 509 PIA Trustees:, Tom Tsvigas, Don McElroy, and Kevin Boatman; Sgt. At Arms, Philip Handscomb: Past President, Dave Bush. Special Projects, Barry Simpson/Trygvi Larum. June Housman & John Eaves, Housman & Assoc. Also in attendance were all 509 PIA members in good standing, who were in Reno, NV, for the 509 PIA Reunion.

#### **AGENDA TOPICS:**

- I. The Membership meeting began with a Call to Order by the Sgt. at Arms. The minutes of the last General Membership Meeting were read by the current Secretary, Margot Handscomb, and approved. Our Treasurer, Dale Fairbanks reported on our change of banks from Wells Fargo to a Credit Union. Our current balance is approximately \$5,000 in checking, and 25,000 in savings.
- II. President Garza announced that the Association members had made visits to at least 3 WWII veterans, and visited the 3<sup>rd</sup> 509 at Fort Richardson, Alaska. Heath Stanley and Philip Handscomb had presented the Order of Geronimo to John Kessler and Keith Houghton.
- III. Barry Simpson, Special Projects, informed the membership that he as working on a "Go Fund Me" page for a reprinting of "Stand in the Door" which is out of print, and for which we have many requests. He is also working on a monument to stand at the Military Museum at Fort Benning, GA. He feels he will have a design available by the 2019 reunion. He feels this acquisition will take a major fund raising effort.
- IV. June Housman presented the top three possible sites for the 2019 reunion. After open discussion from the floor, the following sites resulted from a written vote by membership: 1st place, Fort Smith/Chaffee, AK; 2nd place, St. Louis, MO; 3rd place, Alexandria, LA. June will send out packets to likely hotels in all 3 locations to get bids availability/desirability info. She will get back to the Executive Committee with all information. In 2020 the reunion will be held in the Eastern Third of the US, so suggestions were made, discussion ensued, and a vote was taken. The top three sites were: 1st place, Ft. Walton, FL; 2nd place, Ft. Bragg, NC; 3rc place, Ft. Lee, VA.
- V. John Eaves reported on the progress of the on-line store. He said they were expanding on the number and type of items available, and they were offering T-shirts with color options other than black.
- VI. Barry Simpson attended the Man Of the Year award ceremony in Atlanta, GA, where our 509 Man of the Year, Jaime Garza, was honored.
- VII. A motion was made and seconded from the floor, that 2 DMOR recipients from each of the 1st and 3rd Battalions of the 509th attend the reunion every year, and have their attendance expenses, not covered by the Army, paid for by the 509 PIA. The motion was affirmed by a unanimous vote from the members.
- VIII. Jaime Garza, President, Thanked Ernie, our beloved bartender, for again donating his tips to the 509 PIA,

- IX. Discussion of Officers and Executive Committee members including the fact that Drew Pumarejo will be stepping down as Vice President of the 509 PIA.
